Disinfectant Wipe Station System Overview – UGA Wipe Stations

Purpose

- Disposable disinfectant wipes are being made available at central locations in campus buildings so that commonly used hard surfaces and objects (ie: desktops, classroom chairs, study tables, doorknobs, etc.) can be wiped down before use to help campus stakeholders keep their immediate environment cleaner and safer.
- These wipe stations offer an opportunity for immediate cleaning/ disinfection between custodial routine cleaning of campus spaces.
- The active ingredient in these wipes provide campus stakeholders a mild form of chemical disinfection that is comparable to Clorox and Lysol household disinfecting wipes (but without chlorine bleach) in a safety rating that is still EPA/CDC rated as effective against a broad spectrum of viruses and bacteria.
- Chemical concentration ratings range from 0-4 with 0 = no hazard. The disinfectant rating used in our campus wipe station system is 1.

Disinfectant Wipe Station System Overview

Safety Measures To Provide Clearer Communication

- Revision of labeling on the disinfectant wipe station to include language:
 - "Wipes intended for cleaning/disinfecting hard surfaces only. Not for use as hand sanitizing wipes."
- •Custodial Supervisor to check wipe containers frequently to ensure pH balance and resupply needs
- Labeling on the wipe bucket consistent with campus Right-to-Know guidelines
- •Communication on social media and campus-wide newsletter informing campus stakeholders that the wipes are for hard surface cleaning and not as hand wipes. Communication will inform users to allow the surfaces to dry completely. Limited skin contact and handwashing after use is recommended of any disinfectant use. If skin irritation occurs, users should wash hands immediately with soap and water.
