


NFPA Label

- The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) system shows the type and the degree of a chemical hazard.
- The labels are diamond-shaped and color-coded.
- Hazards are rated from 0 to 4, with 4 = greatest hazard and 0 = no significant hazard.



WHITE gives special information such as "water reactive" or "oxidizer."
