Water Crisis

Facilities Management can make a huge impact in water saving initiatives at UGA. With more than 850 employees at FMD, we all need to work towards reducing water waste.

WE CARE!!

Be Aware

Look for and report leaky faucets (indoors and out), running toilets, dripping water fountains in bathrooms, kitchens, and mechanical rooms.

Turn off the lights and cut the AC back when you're not around. Energy is produced using large volumes of water.





Be Proactive

- Be proactive at home and at work!
- Encourage your co-workers to be attentive and also work to save water.
- Check Equipment – worn, old and poorly maintained equipment can waste significant amounts of water.
- Turn off icemakers – make only what you need.

Minimize Cleaning Water

- Use brooms and dry vacs before washing with water
- Switch from wet carpet cleaning such as steam cleaning to dry or spot cleaning methods
- Reduce the frequency of cleaning external equipment and floors when possible



Water Saving Tips



- Have a rain water collection point for watering indoor and outdoor plants.
- Don't run the faucet to get hot/cold water. Put tap water in the refrigerator to have cold water.
- Don't use the toilet as a trash can.
- Take a short shower instead of a bath.
- Wash only full loads of laundry.
